

**2008 INDICES OF YOUTH NEEDS  
IN SUFFOLK COUNTY**

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Dear Reader:

The **Indices of Youth Needs in Suffolk County** is prepared by the Suffolk County Youth Bureau to assist persons who plan, develop and provide youth services and who seek funding for youth services. The report presents official statistics provided by county and state agencies. The most recent data available have been included, primarily 2003-2007 statistics.

This series of tables is intended to serve as a reference document with current data reflecting levels of youth needs and related information on youth for Suffolk County's ten townships, 166 communities and 71 school districts.

In most cases, the data presented are in the form of raw numbers, that is, cases or incidents, as opposed to rates. Rates are calculated by dividing the number of cases by a fixed number such as 1000. Number of cases and rates are both useful indicators of need. Rates for Suffolk County as a whole are frequently misleading, however, because statistics from communities of greatly differing socio-economic characteristics are combined. The result is a number that does not reflect the existence of communities with severe poverty and social problems.

I want to express particular appreciation for the work of Matt Kinsella, who prepared this report. His conscientious dedication to his work and to detail is apparent.

I hope that readers will find the report of value in their work on behalf of our children and youth.

As shown in the table above, in 2000, there were 418,389 youth under 21 residing in Suffolk, an increase of 7.9% from 1990. The youth population in 2000 accounted for 29.5% of the total population; in 1990, it was 29.3%

Since 1990, the number and percentage of youth in the 0-5 age category has increased moderately. The number and percentage of youth in the 6-14 age category has increased substantially while the number and percentage of youth in the 15-20 age category has experienced a modest decline. Statewide, about 42% of the 21,646 cases closed during 2006 were resolved by the child voluntarily returning home. Law enforcement efforts were involved in the return of 18% of the cases, and 4 children who had been reported missing were found deceased. Also, 60% of all reported cases involved missing females. (The single largest group of cases involved white females 13 years and older – 27% of total cases reported.) Statewide, the median number of days between the reporting and cancellation of a case was four days.


