I. ORDER OF BUSINESS

Call to Order

Chairman Orlowski called the meeting of the Suffolk County Farmland Committee (“Committee”) to order at 6:03 PM at the Long Island Horticultural Research & Extension Center, 3059 Sound Avenue, Riverhead, New York.

Chairman Orlowski introduced Sarah Lansdale the new Director of the Suffolk County Department of Planning.

Approval of Minutes – March 22, 2011

A motion was put forth by Howard Johnson and seconded by Albert Schmitt to approve the minutes of the March 22, 2011 meeting of the Committee as outlined in Committee Resolution FC-10-2011. Motion carried: 13-0-1 [See Exhibit “A” for Committee Resolution FC-10-2011]

Correspondences

Since the last Committee meeting the Suffolk County Department of Planning has received four general correspondence letters on behalf of the Committee. Two letters were from Marie Andrews regarding the Shoreline Development Corp. property and were responded to by the Department of Planning. Two additional letters were written anomalously and were critical of the Suffolk County Purchase of Development Rights Program. Copies of all four letters were provided to the Committee members at the meeting.

II. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Chairman Orlowski opened the meeting for public comments.

Committee Advisor, Joseph M. Gergela, welcomed Sarah Lansdale the new Director of the Suffolk County Department of Planning. Mr. Gergela also discussed pending issues before the New York State Legislature including the expansion of the New York State Central Pine Barrens zone and its potential impacts on farmland in Suffolk County.

No other public comments were made and Chairman Orlowski closed the public comment portion of the meeting.

III. POLICY MATTERS

2011 Agricultural Districts Open Enrollment (pursuant to NYS AML §303-b)

Suffolk County received ten applications consisting of thirty separate parcels in the 2011 Agricultural Districts Open Enrollment Period. Fifteen parcels, totaling 72.4 acres, were recommended by the Suffolk County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board to the Suffolk County Legislature for its consideration. After reviewing these parcels the Legislature will make its recommendations to the Commissioner of the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets.

Suffolk County Aquaculture Lease Program

The Suffolk County Aquaculture Lease Program has been broken down into three cycles. In cycle one there are 21 applications moving forward of which: 5 applications have executed leases, 9 applications are moving forward in the lease execution process, and 7 applications are having the surveys reviewed. In cycle two the County is working with five applicants in the next steps in their conditional lease approvals. In cycle three the County has received 28 applications and on April 21, 2011 a public notice was issued for the received applications. This public notice can be viewed on the Suffolk County Department of Planning website. The public comment period closes on June 24, 2011.

Suffolk County Purchase of Development Rights Program Annual Review Period

The annual review period is new and is the result of the recent amendments to Chapter 8 of the Suffolk County Administrative Code. This annual review period is designed to maximize the County's resources and include the best agricultural land into the Program. The first step of the annual review period is when the Suffolk County Department of Planning posts the new application form on its website. Potential applicants must submit their completed applications in the month of September. The Department of Planning will review the applications in October and make preliminary recommendations to the Farmland Committee in November. The Department of Planning will then review any Farmland Committee's responses from the November Committee meeting and make final recommendations to the Farmland Committee in January of next year.

RESOLUTION NO. FC-12-2011 OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY FARMLAND COMMITTEE, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 8 OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE LOCAL LAWS, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING MODIFICATION TO THE MC CALL FARMS PROPERTY (1000-116.00-01.00-002.002), OF WHICH THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK OWNS THE DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 8 of the Suffolk County Administrative Local Laws (“Chapter 8”), a proposal to modify the property owned by Walker/McCall, LLC has been received by the Suffolk County Farmland Committee (“Committee”); and

WHEREAS, the property owned by Walker/McCall, LLC is located on land situated on the north side of New Suffolk Avenue, east of Locust Avenue, and west of Moores Lane, identified by Suffolk County Real Property Tax Map (“SCRPTM”) number 1000-116.00-01.00-002.002 (“premises”); and

WHEREAS, the applicant seeks an Agricultural Development Permit for the installation and maintenance of one hay barn structure in association with a commercial agricultural operation; and

WHEREAS, said application was considered by the Committee at its meeting on May 24, 2011; now, therefore, be it

1st RESOLVED, that the Committee hereby finds and determines that this proposal constitutes a Type II action pursuant to 6 NYCRR §617.5(c)(3) and (11), which completes the SEQRA review; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the Committee hereby approves and adopts the report of its staff, as may be amended; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that the Committee hereby approves said application subject to the following conditions:

1. One hay barn shall be sited in a location that is approximately located approximately 1,270 feet north of New Suffolk Ave and 400 feet east of the western property boundary;
2. The hay barn shall not exceed a footprint of 30 feet by 40 feet;
3. The livestock barn shall not exceed a height of 28 feet;
4. The livestock barn shall have oak siding, a slate roof, concrete footings and a gravel floor;
5. The livestock barn shall be used to store hay for the herd of cattle on the premises;
6. The landowner shall prepare and implement a stormwater mitigation plan in consultation with Suffolk County Soil and Water Conservation District and/or Natural Resources Conservation Service to address any and all stormwater runoff issues associated with the aforementioned improvements;
7. The landowner shall submit to the Suffolk County Planning Department within one year of permit issuance the Suffolk County Soil and Water Conservation District- and/or Natural Resources Conservation Service-approved stormwater mitigation plan;
8. The landowner shall submit to the Suffolk County Planning Department within one year of permit issuance the as-built survey depicting the aforementioned improvements; and
9. The landowner shall be responsible for compliance with all conditions of this approval, the deed of development rights, the contract of sale, and all applicable statutes, rules, regulations, and guidelines.
