Sealed bids will be received at the Office of Suffolk County Department of Public Works, Purchasing Unit, (Room 132), 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York 11980, until 11:00 AM local time on December 9, 2010 at which time they will be publicly opened and read for:

IMPROVEMENTS TO WATER SUPPLIES AT COUNTY & PARK FACILITIES AT

The work consists of the following: West Hills County Park – Installation of new fire protection and domestic water services, Reduced Pressure Zone (RPZ) devices, precast concrete vault, fire hydrants and various water supply system improvements, and abandonment of an existing water supply well; Various County Facilities - Installation of new water services, RPZ devices, protective enclosures, new water supply well and various water supply system improvements, and abandonment of an existing water supply well.

CONTRACT NO. 2 - PLUMBING

Contract Documents, including Instructions to Bidders, Bid Forms, Specimen Agreement, General Conditions, Specifications, Drawings and other contract documents may be examined and obtained at the Offices of Suffolk County Department of Public Works, Purchasing Unit, Room 132, 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York 11980, between the hours of 9:30AM and 3:30PM daily, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, on or after Tuesday November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting and walkthrough will be held at the Visitors Center in West Hills County Park on Thursday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 10:00AM. Directions to the Visitors Center are as follows:

1. Take the Long Island Expressway to exit 48 and go north on Round Swamp Road.
2. Make a right turn at Highhold Drive (entrance to West Hills County Park).
3. Park in parking lot on north side of Highhold Drive (approximately 0.4 miles).
4. The Visitor Center is located on the south side of the circular driveway across the street from the parking lot.

Note: This Project is to be bid as a **single prime project**. Bidders shall submit with their bids, a separate sealed list that names each subcontractor that the bidder will use to perform work on the contract, and the agreed-upon amount to be paid to each as applicable, for: (a) plumbing and gas fitting (i.e., Plumbing Work), (b) steam heating, hot water heating, ventilating and air conditioning apparatus (i.e., HVAC Work which includes fire sprinkler) and (c) electric wiring and standard illuminating fixtures (i.e., Electrical Work). The apparent low bidder's subcontract information will be opened and read aloud at the bid

opening.

A deposit of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in the form of a check will be required for one full set of Contract Documents. Deposit checks or money orders shall be made payable to the "Suffolk County Treasurer." Cash will not be accepted.

Prospective BIDDERS or their agents will be required to provide the following information in order to obtain a set of Drawings, Project Manual and Proposal Forms: Company Name, Address, Telephone and FAX Number, E-Mail Address, and Federal ID Number.

A full refund will be made to bidders for return of one set of Contract Documents. A 50% refund will be made for return of any additional sets. A 50% refund will be made to Non-Bidders for each set returned. The successful bidder will receive full refund for all sets. Contract Documents must be in good condition and must be returned within thirty (30) days of award or rejection of bids. Deposit on sets not returned within this period will be forfeited.

Bids for this contract shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope with name of the contract clearly noted on the outside of the envelope. Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total Base Bid, made payable to the Suffolk County Treasurer. The bid bond will be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and contract awarded to the Bidder, the contract will be duly executed and properly secured.

Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administration Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.

The bids shall be delivered in person by the Bidder or his agent at the time and place stated.

Then click on Bids and Contracts. Bid Results will not be given out over the telephone. You are requested to access the County website for this information. If you are not in attendance at the bid opening, please be patient while we process and post the results. Results will typically be posted within 24 hours after the bid opening.

Please note that all construction projects over \$250,000 advertised after July 17, 2008 will be subject to training requirements pursuant to Section 220-h of the NYS labor Law.
