



## NYSDEC Endorsed 4-Hour Erosion and Sediment Control Training May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017 9:00 A.M. - 1:00 P.M.

Under the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation's Stormwater Permit GP-0-15-002, all developers, contractors, and subcontractors must identify at least one *trained individual*\* from their company that will be responsible for implementation of the SWPPP, and have at least one *trained individual* on site on a daily basis when soil disturbance activities are being performed. In addition, developers must have a *qualified inspector*\* conduct regular site inspections in accordance with GP-0-15-002.

**\*Qualified inspectors and trained individuals** must have 4 hours of training in the principles and practices of erosion and sediment control endorsed by NYS DEC, SWCD, or CPESC Inc. (Training is valid for 3 years.) Training is **not** required for CPESC, RLA, and PE certified persons.
