EPA Considering Amendments to Sound's Dredged Material Management Plan



On February 10, 2016, The United States Environmental Protection Agency proposed amendments to its 2005 rule that designated the Central and Western Long Island Sound Dredged Material Disposal Sites. If adopted, these amendments will allow previously declared short-term dredge spoil dumping sites to be used for the next 30 years.
