## PRESIDING OFFICER GREGORY HOSTS MOLD REMEDIATION CLINIC

Amityville, NY – Suffolk County Legislature Presiding Officer DuWayne Gregory and Nassau County Legislator Dave Denenberg, to host a mold remediation clinic presented by Community Development Corporation of Long Island for homeowners affected by Superstorm Sandy.
