### **2014 SENIOR CITIZEN OF THE YEAR Presiding Officer DuWayne Gregory Is Seeking Nominees**

Amityville, NY – Suffolk County Legislature Presiding Officer DuWayne Gregory is accepting nominees from the 15<sup>th</sup> Legislative District for ‘Senior Citizen of the Year,’ the Suffolk County Office for the Aging and the Suffolk County Senior Citizens Advisory Board’s annual award.
