PRESIDING OFFICER GREGORY ATTENDS RIBBON CUTTING FOR SENIOR ASSISTED LIVING COMMUNITY



Amityville, NY – Suffolk County Legislature Presiding Officer DuWayne Gregory attended the grand opening of The Bristal at Sayville, an assisted living community for seniors, on May 13 in Sayville.

Presiding Officer Gregory, government officials and administrators from the Bristal commemorated the grand opening. The Bristal at Sayville contains 85 assisted living suites, as well as 51 additional suites dedicated to patients who suffer from Alzheimer’s disease and other memory-related health issues. The Sayville location is the eighth Bristal assisted living community to open on Long Island since 1999.

“On behalf of the residents of Suffolk County, it was my pleasure to help celebrate the grand opening of the Bristal at Sayville,” said Presiding Officer Gregory. “As the number of senior residents in our country continues to increase, there is a growing need for facilities like the Bristal, which help maintain independence, health and quality of life, for our eldest residents and their families.”
