

## HOW TO PARTICIPATE

**1** PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED to participate in CleanSweepNY. Obtain a registration packet from NYSDEC by telephone at 877-793-3769 or by e-mail at: [info@cleansweepny.org](mailto:info@cleansweepny.org)

**2** Return completed registration forms to NYSDEC by these deadlines:  
**September 5, 2014** for participants with unknown products and gas cylinders or  
**September 19, 2014** for all other participants.

About 10 days prior to the event, participants will be sent a CleanSweepNY appointment card which will include your drop-off date, time, and location.

**3** Safely transport unusable pesticides and chemicals to the assigned collection site. Once there, please stay in your vehicle and present your shipping papers that were provided with the CleanSweepNY instructions.

**4** If you are bringing in chemical wastes that are NOT pesticides, please be prepared to pay a nominal disposal fee to the contracted CleanSweepNY waste hauler.

## FALL CLEANSWEEPNY

### COLLECTION OF PESTICIDES AND OTHER TARGETED MATERIALS

CleanSweepNY is sponsored and administered by the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation through its Albany, NY Central Office Pest Management Program. CleanSweepNY provides for the safe economic collection and disposal of unwanted or unusable pesticides, lab chemicals, elemental mercury, and mercury containing devices such as thermometers.

CleanSweepNY also collects for recycling, triple-rinsed high density polyethylene (HDPE, #2) plastic pesticide containers from agricultural and certain non-agricultural entities.

CleanSweepNY results in enhanced stewardship of the environment through improved management of unusable pesticides and chemicals wastes. These materials can pose human health risks upon exposure and a significant hazard to groundwater and surface water resources.

The following is CleanSweepNY information on the types of materials collected, who can participate, and what materials are accepted for disposal at no or low cost:

- ✚ Unwanted or unusable pesticides
- ✚ School laboratory chemicals
- ✚ Elemental mercury and mercury containing devices such as thermometers
- ✚ Triple-rinsed HDPE #2 plastic containers
- ✚ Compressed gas cylinders (which must be pre-registered and identified)

If unknown materials are present, an onsite visit may be necessary to assess any potential hazard with their transport.

### WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- ✚ Farmers and owners of former farms
- ✚ All categories of NYS certified pesticide applicators
- ✚ Cemeteries, golf courses and marinas
- ✚ Retailers of agricultural, commercial or home/garden pesticide products

CleanSweepNY collection efforts are directed towards private and professional applicators and schools, and not towards homeowners. See household hazardous waste events in your area at:
