Open on Sunday mornings from 8:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m., the open air market typically offers vegetables, fruit, eggs, plants and baked goods. Additionally, there are local artisans selling handmade soaps, jewelry, pottery, and more.

The goal of the market is to help the community get to know the great farmers on Long Island as well as learn about their growing practices.

“Long Island has the largest farming community in New York State,” said Legislator Anker.
