Anker Honors Mount Sinai High School for Earning “Reward School” Recognition

Mount Sinai, NY; October 2014 – Suffolk County Legislator Sarah Anker recently honored Mount Sinai High School for earning the distinguished title of “Reward School” by the New York State Education Department for the 2014-2015 school year. The New York State Department of Education distinguishes Reward Schools as schools that have high achievement or schools that have made the most progress in the state and do not have significant gaps in student achievement.

“As a former Mount Sinai School Board member, it is with great pride that I present our high school with a Certificate of Notable Recognition in honor of the school’s dedication to excellence,” said Legislator Anker. “The Mount Sinai School District has a proven track record of academic achievement and I wish the district much continued success.”

To be identified as a Reward School, the Mount Sinai High School was required to meet specific criteria including:

- A four-year graduation rate for the 2007 cohort (students who entered 9th grade in 2007) at 98 percent.
- An average for Regents Diplomas with Advanced Designation of 60 percent, compared to the state average of 31 percent.
- A combined unweighted ELA and Math Performance Index within the top 20 percent of all NYS schools.
