Legislator Lou D'Amaro Informs Residents About Civil Service Exam E-Mail Alert Program

(HUNTINGTON STATION, NY... February 23, 2010) – Suffolk Legislator Lou D'Amaro (D-Huntington Station) is pleased to inform residents that new employment opportunities may be just a mouse click away, now that individuals interested in receiving civil service announcements can sign up to receive e-Updates on scheduled exams and available positions. The new program, administered through the Suffolk County Department of Human Resources and Civil Service, provides information on positions available locally and across the country.

In addition to receiving information about exam notifications, users may also sign up to receive e-Updates in other areas of interest, including transportation, jobs and housing.

Suffolk County administers competitive exams for job titles in over 241 jurisdictions including the county, its 10 towns and the multitude of villages, school districts and fire, water and library special districts. In past years, up to 300 exams were administered for these jurisdictions, which collectively employ almost 50,000 individuals.

“The new e-Update notification program is another way for individuals to enhance their job searches, and I urge everyone to sign up for the great free service,” D’Amaro said.
