May 25, 2010)* – Citing her bravery and impressive record of service to the Babylon community, Suffolk County Legislators Lou D’Amaro (D-North Babylon) and Steve Stern (D-Huntington) recently joined with a host of other dignitaries, community leaders, family members and friends to recognize Police Officer Christina Amorin on being named the First Precinct’s 2009 Top Cop during a ceremony hosted by the Knights of Columbus, Our Lady of the Rosary Council in Deer Park.
