(NORTH BABYLON, NY... July 23, 2012) – Nine-year NYPD Officer Andre Menzies was returning home from work in November 2010 when his life was tragically cut short by a wrong-way drunk driver on the Northern State Parkway in Dix Hills. Babylon officials paid tribute to his bravery and service by dedicating the street in North Babylon where he resided in a special ceremony on Saturday, July 14th.

Joining Officer Menzies' family as Earl Street between Bay Shore Road and Noble Street was renamed "Police Officer Andre Menzies Street" were Babylon Supervisor Rich Schaffer, Councilmen Thomas Donnelly, Tony Martinez and Lindsay Henry, Alternate Council member Ellen McVeety and Suffolk Legislator Lou D'Amaro (D-North Babylon).

In accordance with the street renaming, authorized by a Town of Babylon resolution, street signs have been posted at both ends of Earl Street, which is located three blocks East of Commack Road on the South side of Bay Shore Road.
