Legislator D'Amaro and County Office for the Aging Announce Huntington Fall Senior Advocate Schedule

(HUNTINGTON STATION, NY... October 15, 2012) – Legislator Lou D'Amaro (D-Huntington Station) is alerting local residents about the Suffolk County Office for the Aging's Fall 2012 Senior Advocate Schedule. Senior advocates are County representatives who come out to the local community and assist seniors with information gathering, completion of eligibility or recertification applications and referrals to appropriate community agencies.

"Nobody should ever have to go without food, medical attention or other necessities, which is why our senior advocates literally bring these vital programs and services directly to our seniors in their own communities," D'Amaro said.

Senior Advocates meet with interested and needy seniors aged 60 and over at regularly-scheduled times in specific locations throughout the community. This fall, they are visiting the following locations in the Town of Huntington:

- Huntington Nutrition Center: Wednesdays, October 24, November 28 and December 20 from 9 am – 12 pm

- Paumanack Village I & II (Greenlawn): Tuesdays, October 23, November 29 and December 18 from 10 am – 1 pm
- Paumanack Village III & IV (Greenlawn): Thursday, December 13 from 10 am – 12 pm
- Paumanack Village V & VI (Melville): Tuesdays, November 13 and December 11 from 9 am – 12 pm
- South Huntington Library: Thursday, October 25 from 10 am – 11:30 am
- Huntington Library: Monday, November 19 from 10 am – 12 pm

Advocates provide assistance with food stamps, Medicare savings programs, Medicaid applications and Heating Emergency Assistance Program (HEAP) applications. They also answer questions and make additional recommendations and referrals.

For more information about available services, or for directions to any of the locations, please call the Suffolk County Office for the Aging at (631) 853-8200. Appointments are encouraged but drop-ins are also welcome. No individual will ever be turned away.
