## Legislator D'Amaro to Recognize Local Woman of Distinction; Community Members Encouraged to Apply or Nominate

*(HUNTINGTON STATION, NY.... January 13, 2014)* – In conjunction with Women's History Month in March, Suffolk County Legislator Lou D'Amaro (D-Huntington Station) is seeking to honor a service-oriented woman who has demonstrated leadership, involvement and commitment to her community as the 17<sup>th</sup> Legislative District "Woman of Distinction" for 2014. If you live in one of the communities covered by Legislator D'Amaro's district and this sounds like you or someone you know, now is the time to apply!

In 2002, the Suffolk County Legislature passed a Resolution authorizing each County Legislator to honor a "Woman of Distinction" from their local district.
