Legislator D'Amaro Informs Seniors About Free Babylon and Huntington Residential Repair Programs

(HUNTINGTON STATION, NY... August 15, 2016) – Suffolk Legislator Lou D'Amaro (D-Huntington Station) is pleased to inform local senior citizens about town-based programs designed to help them maintain and stay in their homes. Both the Babylon and Huntington programs offer free craftsmen who are available by appointment to provide simple home repairs and installations for residents aged 60 and older. Many services can be provided, with the exception of those that require the skills of a licensed craftsman.

“Owning and maintaining a home can be a tremendous physical and financial burden,” Legislator D'Amaro said. “However, these great programs make it easier for seniors to stay in the homes that they have lived and raised their families in for their entire lives.”

Eligible residents must reside in the Town of Babylon or Town of Huntington, own their own homes and live alone or with other seniors. Program volunteers provide simple maintenance and repair services like cleaning gutters, fixing faucets and

installing special-needs hand rails and smoke alarms. Clients are responsible for the cost of the materials but the installation and repair work is free.
