## **Leg. D'Amaro Informs Veterans About Local Resource Center's Services Days**

September 29, 2016)* – Suffolk Legislator Lou D'Amaro, a member of the Legislature's Veterans Committee, would like to inform local veterans that the Huntington Opportunity Resource Center, in partnership with Suffolk County, is hosting three upcoming Monthly Veterans Services Days in Huntington Station.

On October 14, November 4 and December 9, 2016, veterans' services providers, human services providers and other not-for-profit agencies will be available at the Huntington Opportunity Resource Center from 10 am to 3 pm to provide assistance and guidance to all veterans seeking, and interested in finding more about, available services. In addition to the providers, the Suffolk County Police Department will be conducting a "Shed the Meds" program so that unused, unneeded and/or expired medications can be safely handed over for proper disposal.
