Selden, NY –On September 9, Legislator Tom Muratore (R-Ronkonkoma) joined the Town of Brookhaven in breaking ground for two new little league ball fields in Selden that will be used by the Middle Country Youth Association, among other organizations. The new ball field project, which will be completed by the spring of 2015, is the first phase of a future 24-acre athletic complex on the site. The property, purchased by Suffolk County and transferred to the Town of Brookhaven, is located behind the Grace Presbyterian Church at 425 Hawkins Road in Selden.

"I want to congratulate the County and the Town on breaking ground for this much needed family-friendly place in the community," Legislator Tom Muratore commented.
