Legislators Muratore and Anker Recognize
December 19th as Richard "Rees" Specht Day of Kindness

Selden, NY – At the December 15th General Meeting of the Suffolk County Legislature, Legislators Tom Muratore (R-Ronkonkoma) and Sarah Anker presented a proclamation to the Specht family of Sound Beach in memory of their young son, Richard "Rees" Edwin-Ehmer Specht.

Rees' father, Richard E. Specht, Jr. established a 501 © 3 non-profit named Rees Specht Life, an organization committed to making the world a better place by asking the community to commit random acts of kindness in his son's name.

Resolution #685, introduced by Legislator Tom Muratore and adopted by the Suffolk County Legislature on September 9, 2014, declares that December 19th be designated as the Richard "Rees" Specht Day of Kindness in Suffolk County. "That day was chosen because December 19th was Rees' birthday," stated Legislator Muratore. "To honor the memory of Rees and the kindness he engendered, Suffolk County encourages acts of kindness towards loved ones and strangers every day of the year."
