**Legislator Muratore-
“Sign up for the Suffolk County Police Civil Service Exam”**

Selden, NY –Suffolk County Legislator Tom Muratore (R-Ronkonkoma) would like to remind all eligible residents that the deadline date to take the SCPD Exam is rapidly approaching. The last day to file your application is **April 1st, 2015**. Application fee is \$100.

On **June 13, 2015**, the Suffolk County Department of Civil Service is offering an entrance examination for the position of Police Officer. This exam is offered once every four years. “As a legislator and retired member of the SCPD, I consider public safety to be a high priority,” commented Legislator Muratore. “I am pleased that the exam is being offered again to add to the ranks of Suffolk County’s finest. Those who meet the eligibility requirements are encouraged to sign up before the deadline date.”

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Age

Minimum age: 19 years on the date of the written test to be eligible for appointment. Maximum age: 34 years on the date of the written test. (Applicants with active military duty, as defined in Section 243 (10-a) of the New York State Military Law, may deduct up to six years from their age to meet the maximum age requirement).

Education

Graduation from a standard senior high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma recognized by the New York State Department of Education, by the date of appointment. (No college required for appointment)

License Requirement

Possession of a valid New York State operator's or chauffeur's license at the time of appointment.

Written Examination

Candidates who attain a reachable passing grade will have to pass the following qualifying tests and evaluations: Medical, Personality Assessment, Polygraph, Extensive Background Check & [Physical Fitness Screening](#).

Citizenship

Candidate must be a NY State resident and a US citizen at time of appointment.

To assist efforts with attracting qualified candidates, the Police Department is offering informational seminars to explain the process of becoming a Suffolk County Police Officer. Representatives from the Suffolk County Police recruitment unit, applicant investigation unit, and Civil Service will be in attendance.
