Selden, NY –Legislator Tom Muratore (R-Ronkonkoma) wants constituents aged 60 and over in the Fourth Legislative District to be aware of the Senior Advocate Meetings being held in this community for the months of April and May.

Each month, the Suffolk County Office for the Aging holds these meetings throughout the county, geared specifically for the senior population. Goals for the Office for the Aging include developing a comprehensive service system designed to assist persons 60 years of age and older in maintaining maximum independence and dignity, removing barriers to economic and personal independence, and providing a continuum of care for the vulnerable elderly. Most importantly, representatives act as advocates for those applying for Social Security income, food stamps (SNAP program), Medicare/Medicaid/Medigap concerns, senior ID cards, HEAP (Heating Emergency Assistance Program) benefits and other services.
