Selden, New York- Suffolk County Legislator Tom Muratore was given a pleasant surprise while running a local errand. As he approached the Suffolk Federal Credit Union on Horseblock Road in Medford, the legislator noticed a sign designating the parking space for veterans only. This discovery was significant to Legislator Muratore because of a bill he introduced earlier this year, adopted as Local Law 21, "to provide designated parking for veterans at county facilities."

"Suffolk County has the largest population of veterans in New York State. I'd like to thank the credit union, a private company that took initiative on their own," stated Legislator Muratore. "They recognize the importance of helping and acknowledging our veterans, no matter how small a gesture, which was the intent of my bill. I hope to see other local businesses join this endeavor."
