Suffolk County Legislator Rob Trotta Sworn in as the New Legislator for the 13th Legislative District

(Smithtown, NY)...Suffolk County Legislator Rob Trotta was proudly sworn in as the County Legislator representing the 13th Legislative District, which includes Smithtown,

Fort Salonga, Kings Park, San Remo, Nissequogue, Head of the Harbor and St. James, as well as portions of Commack, Northport and East Northport on January 2, 2014. He is a life-long resident of the 13th Legislative District. He grew up in Commack and graduated from Commack High School in 1979. Rob currently lives in Fort Salonga with his wife, two children and their dog.

Rob graduated from C. W. Post with a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice and from Stony Brook University with a Master's Degree in Labor Management Relations. In 1988, he became a Suffolk County Police officer. His hard work and passion for the job were recognized on several occasions by his superiors, including "Cop of the Year" in 1993 and "Detective of the Year" in 2001. For over 10 years, he was assigned to the FBI Violent Crime Task, working on complex cases involving money laundering to the confiscation of large quantities of cocaine from our streets. His efforts helped make our families and neighborhoods safer.

While serving with the police department, Rob was also active with several local organizations, including Kings Park Soccer, Kings Park Neighborhood Association, the Nissequogue River State Park Foundation and the Kings Park Civic Association. In 2005, Rob helped lead an effort to prevent the development of up to 2,500 units of housing on the former Kings Park State Hospital property. He advocated for and eventually won state support for the transfer of the 365 acre property to New York State Parks in 2006. As a board member with the Nissequogue River State Park Foundation, he helped raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for beautification and restoration projects, and persuade the state to begin the first phase of the park's cleanup in 2012-2013.

In early 2013, Rob decided to run for the office of Suffolk County Legislator and was elected to the position in November 2013. At the end of last year, Rob retired from the Police Department. Legislator Trotta has vowed to put you, the taxpayer, first and to become Suffolk County's hardest working legislator dedicated to improving the economy and our residents' quality of life.
