Legislator Robert Trotta Conducts Year - Round Food Drive for the Smithtown Emergency Food Pantry

(Smithtown, NY)...Suffolk County Legislator Robert Trotta is using his office to host a year-round food drive for the Smithtown Emergency Food Pantry, which is housed at the St. Thomas of Canterbury Church in Smithtown and has been in existence for more than 29 years. It is supported by donations from the community, as well as the parishioners of seven churches (Byzantine Church of the Resurrection, First Presbyterian Church of Smithtown, St. Andrews Lutheran, St. James Episcopal, St. James Lutheran, St. Thomas of Canterbury and Smithtown United Methodist). Volunteers from these seven churches are assigned a month in which to operate and staff the Food Pantry.

Legislator Trotta will be collecting non- perishable food items for breakfast, lunch, dinner and snacks, toiletries, baby food and formula, diapers, paper products, pet food and school supplies. Donations may be dropped off Monday through Friday from 9am until 4:30pm at Legislator Trotta's district office at 59 Landing Avenue in Smithtown.
