Legislator Trotta recently retired from the Suffolk County Police Department with the rank of detective and spent over 10 years assigned to the FBI's Violent Crime Task Force, where he worked on complex cases ranging from money laundering to confiscating large quantities of cocaine from our streets. Students had numerous questions for him regarding gangs, arrest procedures, drug seizures, as well as how to become a police officer.
