The Mike Greene Great Guy Foundation was founded in 2007 by friends of Michael J. Greene in his memory. The purpose of the Foundation is to raise funds and donate those funds to help families and individuals in need in Babylon Village and its surrounding communities. Greene was an active community member who gave his life as a volunteer who was committed to serving and protecting his community.

“The Mike Greene Great Guy Foundation is a meaningful effort to carry on the name and legacy of a man who dedicated his life to saving lives and was killed in the line of duty as a fireman,” said Legislator McCaffrey. “I am proud to have presented a proclamation to the people who work to carry out his legacy in the community.”
