LESLIE KENNEDY AND ROB TROTTA HONOR LOCAL STUDENT DAVID LI

July 28, 2015 – The Suffolk County Legislature General Meeting took place this past Tuesday; before the meeting began, Legislator Leslie Kennedy (R- Nesconset) and Legislator Rob Trotta (R-Fort Salonga) proudly recognized Commack High School Student David Li for his distinguished work in technology, computer science, mathematics and engineering.

David is a rising senior of Commack School District; he is the President of the Computer Science Club and is a distinguished member of the National Technological Honor Society. David is also active outside of his local academic community. He is a member of the Suffolk County All-Star Math Team and is the recipient of numerous awards in mathematics such as: American Mathematics Contest 10 National Distinguished Honor Roll and the American Mathematics Contest 12 National Honor Society. In addition to mathematics, David is also the Grand Prize Winner of the Long Island Science and Engineering Fair (LISEF). These outstanding awards only scratch the surface of David's list of accomplishments.

David's latest work includes his own personal invention: a Medical Tracking System for Natural Disasters. This device is a wireless tracking system for at-home medical equipment that will help for preparation for natural disasters. David was recently invited to Washington D.C. by Rear Admiral of the U.S. Public Health Service and Assistant Secretary of Preparedness and Response of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Dr. Nicole Lurie; David gave a presentation on his invention to several government officials who specialize in the field of technology.

"It is young people like David who make this county so remarkable, it brings me great delight to see young students like him succeed, he certainly has an incredibly bright future!" said Leslie.

The Suffolk County Legislature bestowed honor to him through a Proclamation, this was to show the community how influential David Li has been and will be in his upcoming endeavors. David intends to major in electrical engineering and computer science (EECS) after he graduates high school in 2016.
