LESLIE KENNEDY MEETS WITH COMMACK-KINGS PARK ROTARY

Many questions were raised about the new plastic bag bill currently being debated in the legislature, as well as the bill to register and charge owners of home alarm systems.

President of the Rotary Club Joanne Maiorana-Davis was particularly interested in what Leslie had to say and about the current business of the County Legislature:

"It was interesting to learn about Leslie Kennedy's background and experience at the Commack-Kings Park Rotary Club's meeting. As our Guest Speaker, she enlightened us with the latest environmental issues, particularly the use of plastic bags in most grocery stores and the legislation

aimed at substituting them with paper bags. The other problem, was if we use paper bags do the stores charge the consumer 10 cents per bag to cover the additional cost or will it encourage consumers to carry their own bags to help save the earth. It was a controversial issue. Everyone needs to make a conscientious choice to help keep our environment clean and we need to work together to make that happen."

Leslie was happy to take the business of the Legislature to the people and see what input they have on how their government is run: "Ultimately the people are our boss, and we attempt to make legislation that benefits them. Since I work for them its only right that I get their input on our work" said Legislator Kennedy
