Centerport, NY - Aggressive water quality clean-up efforts have paid off for the Centerport Yacht Club Beach as it is poised to re-open after being shut down seven years ago due to water quality concerns. Northport Harbor, once the epicenter of red-tide in the Northeast, has continued to see positive results as the red-tide has not returned in three seasons. Now, with the Suffolk County and New York State Departments of Health seal of approval, County Executive Steve Bellone and Legislator William R. Spencer will hand deliver the beach permit to the community and *Reclaim our Water!*
