## **Legislator Spencer Sworn into his 3<sup>rd</sup> Term**

**Hauppauge, NY** - Joined by his family and colleagues at the organizational meeting of the Suffolk County Legislature on Monday, Legislator William R. Spencer, M.D. took the oath of office, beginning his third term representing the 18<sup>th</sup> Legislative District.

“Thank you to the voters who have entrusted me to serve as their Legislator for another two years. I am so proud of this district, and will continue to do all that I can to make our community the best it can be.” said Legislator Spencer. “I look forward to continuing the work of the people in the years to come.”

Since first taking office four years ago, health and public safety, preserving Long Island’s surface and ground waters, veterans, and providing opportunities for our youth have been major focuses during his tenure. Some of his key accomplishments thus far include: raising the tobacco purchasing age to 21, Suffolk County’s Stolen Valor Act and Sunlight Law, the first in the nation stimulant drink education & protection plan, the creation of the Long Island Council on Aquifer Protection (LICAP), laws prohibiting the use of hydro-fracking by-products within Suffolk, and the “Lead by Example” Summer Internship Program.
