East end drug investigation results in six arrests

Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota today announced the arrests of six men and women following an investigation by the East End Drug Task Force.

"A quantity of cocaine and prescription medication was seized during this ten-month investigation by East End Drug Task Force personnel," Spota said. "The investigation is ongoing."

Each of the following defendants pleaded not guilty to drug charges:

ARRESTED ON April 18, 2012

Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the third degree (3 counts)
Conspiracy in the fourth degree

Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the second degree (2 counts)
Criminal sale of a controlled Substance in the third degree (3 counts)

Frederick Wilkinson 69 13 Scrub Oak Rd., Quogue

Criminal sale of a controlled substance in the third degree
Criminal possession of a controlled substance in the seventh degree (Defendant was in possession of less than a gram of cocaine when he was arrested.)
Wilkinson was given a field appearance ticket returnable to Quogue Village Justice Court.

Conspiracy 4th Additionally the EEDTF along with SCPD Emergency Services and the SCPD K9 unit executed a search warrant at the Turner and Gilmore residence on April 20, 2012. Among the items seized: cash, a Mossberg short barreled pump shotgun and an AK 47 assault rifle.

Criminal sale of a controlled substance in the third degree

Criminal possession of a controlled substance in the seventh degree (4 counts) Additionally the EEDTF along with SCPD Emergency Services and the SCPD K9 unit executed a search warrant at Hanley's residence on Head of Neck Rd in Manorville. Hanley was found to be in possession of 41 oxycodone pills, 3 oxycontin pills and a small quantity of cocaine and marijuana.

The East End Drug Task Force is a multi-jurisdictional drug enforcement unit funded and supervised by the office of Thomas J. Spota, Suffolk County District Attorney. The team is comprised of detectives and officers from east end police departments, the Suffolk County Police Department's Emergency Services and Narcotics sections, NY State Police, the Suffolk County Sheriff's department, Suffolk County Park Police and the County Department of Probation.
