SCDA Court Calendar Advisory

For Friday April 15, 2016

Former Suffolk County Police Sgt. Scott Greene is scheduled to appear before State Supreme Court Justice Fernando Camacho in Central Islip (third floor of the courthouse) today, Friday, April 15.

Greene, 52, was convicted in January of stealing money from two Hispanic motorists. A jury acquitted Greene of grand larceny as a hate crime charges. He was sentenced last month to 1 to 3 years in prison; the district attorney's office recommended the maximum four-year sentence. During the sentencing, Justice Camacho said that he agreed with the jury's decision not to convict Greene of hate crimes, stating that he believed the defendant's thefts of cash from Hispanic motorists were "borne out of opportunistic bias".

Friday's court appearance is a scheduled hearing on a second indictment charging Greene with more thefts.

Greene has been incarcerated in the county jail since his conviction.

Justice Camacho will call the court calendar at 9:30 am.
