## **Arraignment in Riverhead tomorrow for Nesconset couple facing drugs and weapons charges**

A Nesconset couple arrested on December 24 for gun and narcotics possession will be arraigned on an indictment tomorrow in Riverhead, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

Police investigating a domestic disturbance on Avalon Circle arrested Neil Ross-France, 26, for allegedly firing a shot into his floor into an apartment below.

Ross-France and his partner, Dominica Kaisen, 24, of 36 Avalon Circle were charged with drug possession, criminal possession of a weapon and endangering the welfare of a child charges after police discovered a loaded handgun, a loaded shotgun, ammunition clips, powdered and crack cocaine and marijuana under the bed of their four-year-old child. Ross-France was also charged with reckless endangerment in the first degree and obstructing governmental administration

The defendants will appear for arraignment tomorrow (Thursday Jan.5) in Riverhead before State Supreme Court Justice Mark Cohen (fourth floor of the courthouse).
