## **Suspects in knifepoint robberies to be arraigned tomorrow in Riverhead**

A 30 year old man arrested for a series of knifepoint robberies on Long Island will be arraigned tomorrow (5/11) with two codefendants in Riverhead, Suffolk County District Attorney Spota said.

Shane Cashmore, Paul Drab, 26, and Juliana Pantaleone, 31, were charged with robbery in the first degree after a robbery of a Huntington Station ice cream store on New York Avenue on May 1.

Cashmore said he robbed the stores because of his addiction to heroin.

The trio will appear before Judge Timothy Mazzei (second floor of the courthouse). The court calendar starts at 9:30 am.
