SUFFOLK LAUNCHES VIRTUAL CAREER & TALENT CENTER

In June, Suffolk Executive Steve Bellone unwrapped the County's new job portal for employers and jobseekers alike. Faced with the Covid 19-induced "new normal", Bellone instituted Suffolk County NY Forward as Long Island begins to re-open, and tasked the county Department of Labor, Licensing & Consumer Affairs to provide services in a virtual setting.

The result is an up to date, extensive web-based [Virtual Career & Talent Center](#), bringing all the programs and services available in the bricks and mortar One-Stop Employment Center online.

SUFFOLK FORWARD VIRTUAL JOB BOARD

Part of the Suffolk Forward Main Street Initiative, Virtual Career & Talent Portal is a newly-developed Internet-based job board that serves as a one-stop-shop for employers and jobseekers.

"Residents are provided access to local job opportunities & businesses can choose among a pool of talented applicants searching for new employment opportunities", said Bellone. "I encourage everyone to virtually visit the website and access our Labor Department services from the safety of their own home."
