**Many insurance plans
will cover screening
if you are:**

- **Between the ages
of 55-80**
- **Are a current smoker,
or have quit within
the last 15 years**
- **Have smoked the
equivalent of 30
pack years (2 packs a
day for 15 years, etc.)**

**A low dose CT scan
takes only 10
minutes and can
save your life.**

**Early-stage lung
cancer often has
no symptoms.**

**It is important to
be screened and
catch lung cancer
before it spreads.**
