The meeting of the Suffolk County Planning Commission was called to order by Chairman Eversoll at 12:10 P.M. in the Suffolk County Arthur H. Kunz Memorial Library.

#### **Minutes:**

On a motion by Commissioner Petersen, seconded by Commissioner Rosavitch, the minutes of the January 3, 2001, Planning Commission meeting were unanimously approved.

#### **Election of Officers:**

Commissioner Martin made a motion to nominate Commissioner Eversoll for reappointment to the Office of Chairman. The motion was seconded by Commissioner O'Dea and passed by unanimous vote.

Commissioner London made a motion to nominate Commissioner Martin for reappointment to the Office of Vice Chairman. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Thorsen and passed by unanimous vote.

Commissioner Rosavitch made a motion to nominate Commissioner Dietz for reappointment to the Office of Secretary. The motion was seconded by Commissioner O'Dea and passed by unanimous vote.

## **Deputy Director's Report:**

Mr. Withers announced to the Commission that with regard to the appointment of Tom Isles, there is a Committee Hearing scheduled for February 16 for Planning and Open Space Acquisitions. Mr. Isles will be on the agenda of the next legislative meeting. If all meetings go as scheduled, Mr. Isles should be present, as Director, at the next Commission meeting in March.

#### **Commissioners' Roundtable:**

Commissioner Thorsen stated that the Town Board of East Hampton distributed a pamphlet showing a progress report on the 2% real estate transfer tax. It has brought in approximately \$12.5 million which is good in leveraging approximately \$36 million. Through cooperative agreements with the County and the State of New York, 672 acres of open space have been acquired in the 18 months it has been in service. Another 165 acres of woodlands, known as Jacob's Farm, are being acquired in a Town/County partnership with help from the Peconic Land Trust. Collecting the transfer tax is assisting in the open space acquisitions.

Commissioner Petersen stated that Brookhaven's new Supervisor, John J. LaValle, is very interested in planning, and intends to take another look at the land use plan for the Town of Brookhaven.

Commissioner O'Dea stated that the Town of Riverhead is moving forward with the Burman people in an effort to get the industrial area of the Grumman contract fulfilled.
